PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

This cleaner/sanitizer provides grease-cutting detergents to remove stubborn soil deposits, quaternary compounds to reduce bacterial contamination and odor counteractants to leave carpets smelling fresh. Not wool or wool-blend safe. For use with carpet extractors and carpet steam cleaning equipment. EPA registered.

USE

FOR HOSPITAL, INSTITUTIONAL AND INDUSTRIAL USE

Sani-Tex should be an integral part of any carpet maintenance system. Routine application will not only clean the carpets, but sanitize and deodorize for a cleaner, longer lasting carpet. *Sani-Tex* is a low foaming carpet shampoo formulated for use with extraction and carpet steam cleaning equipment. *Sani-Tex* contains "twin chain" quaternary ammonium compounds to reduce and control the growth of gram negative and gram positive odor causing bacteria. *Sani-Tex* is fortified with odor counteractants to neutralize unpleasant malodors. Recommended for use on wet cleanable synthetic fibers, but not recommended for use on wool carpets. *Sani-Tex* effectively and economically lifts and removes greasy soil, resists resoiling and utilizes "built-in" defoamers for more productive use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CLEAN, SANITIZE, AND DEODORIZE CARPETS:

STEAM EXTRACTION: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix two (2) ounces of *Sani-Tex* per gallon of water. Inject and extract as you would any steam cleaning shampoo.

SPIN BONNET (BONNET BUFF) CLEANING: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix four (4) ounces of *Sani-Tex* per gallon of water. Bonnet on carpet at rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon.

HEAVY DUTY SPIN BONNET (BONNET BUFF) CLEANING: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix sixteen (16) ounces of *Sani-Tex* per gallon of water. Spray on carpet at rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon.

NOTE: Test color fastness of carpet before use. Apply diluted cleaner to a small concealed spot, then rub with clean white cloth. If color transfers to cloth or changes, a water-based product should not be used.

NOTE: Not recommended for use on (Fifth Generation) Stain-Resistant Nylon Carpets. Consult carpet manufacturer's warranty and maintenance instructions for proper use. After cleaning, set carpet pile in one direction with a stiff brush (carpet pilator). Place aluminum foil under legs of furniture while carpet is drying. Over-wetting can cause shrinkage of carpet. Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for over-wetting or misuse.
